US REPRESENTATIVE DAVID MCKINLEY WILL ADDRESS STATE PRO-LIFE CONVENTION CROWD IN LOST CREEK

West Virginians for Life invites all to gather in the Horizons Church gymnasium at 8302 Mt. Clare Road in Lost Creek, WV, on Saturday, October 21, from 10:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. for the Annual West Virginians for Life Convention where the theme will be "LIFE IS FOR EVERYONE." Doors will open at 9:00.

Wesley J. Smith, JD, will be the key presenter. His topic will be *How to Keep Assisted Suicide from Conquering America*. Smith is a world-renowned bioethicist who is frequently called upon to testify before Congress. He has authored/co-authored 14 books. He will sign his latest, *Culture of Death*, during a portion of the day. In addition, presenters will include Dr. Wanda Franz, President of West Virginians for Life, on the legislative agenda for 2018, and National Right to Life Political Director Karen Cross, whose topic will address the election battle before us in the year to come. Learn about the mindset behind doctor-prescribed suicide from Deborah Sturm, RN, MA, and leave with a pro-life *Will to Live* in hand.

During the noon luncheon, the crowd will be addressed by First District Congressman David McKinley, while other elected officials will be introduced.

The Teen Day Camp is an added feature. Catering to teens, the day camp will provide time for games in addition to the learning.

Attendees will again be treated to short but information-packed presentations with music and pro-life video clips interspersed. Random prize giveaways are also a fun part of the conference.

Lunch is included in the \$35 cost. It's \$20 for college students and teens. Childcare is available, provided that request is known in advance.

This is a catered event, so WVFL emphasizes early registration by October 14. After that, the price goes up.

West Virginians for Life, the state affiliate to the National Right to Life Committee, is the only statewide non-partisan organization solely dedicated to the protection of human life.
